University of Delaware

**Martin Ingelsby**, recently hired as head coach at Delaware, spent 13 seasons on the Notre Dame coaching staff & helped lead the Irish to 8 NCAA Tournaments. Ingelsby was a standout guard for Notre Dame from 97-01. He began his career as an asst at Wagner College during the 02-03 campaign before returning to his alma mater. The Fighting Irish advanced to the NCAA Tournament's Elite 8 in both 15' & 16'. The Irish won the ACC Tournament title, made its first Elite 8 appearance since 79', & posted a 32-6 mark. Ingelsby helped lead Notre Dame to a school-record 7 consecutive 20-win seasons from 06-13, while the Irish posted 97 victories from 09-13, the most wins in a 4-year period in school history. During Ingelsby's 13 seasons at his alma mater, Irish teams have gone 290-146 (.665) & the program has posted a 168-76.



American University

**Mike Brennan** returned to AU as head coach after 4 years as an asst coach at Georgetown and led AU to its 3<sup>rd</sup> Patriot League Championship in his 1<sup>st</sup> season. In his 2<sup>nd</sup> season with the Eagles, Brennan guided the squad back to the PL Championship. Brennan was named the PL Coach of the Year. Brennan was on staff for each of AU's PL championship teams as an Asst Coach. Brennan came to AU from his alma mater, Princeton University. He spent 7 seasons with the Tigers, guiding the squad to 3 Ivy League titles as the top assistant. Brennan served 1 season as a volunteer assistant coach at Columbia University. He was a 4-year starter at Princeton. Brennan helped lead his team to Ivy League championships & the NCAA Tournament in 91 & 92. He was named 2<sup>nd</sup> Team All-Ivy in 94'.



Rutgers University

**Steve Pikiell** took Stony Brook to 6 post-season appearances over the past 7 years & was recently named the head coach at Rutgers. During his tenure, the Seawolves won 4 America East regular season championships, achieved 22 or more victories on 6 occasions & captured 5 conference player of the year awards. A 4-time America East Coach of the Year, Pikiell compiled a 119-48 (.713) record over the past 5 seasons. In the 15-16 season, Pikiell posted a 26-7 (14-2) record, won the America East regular & post-season titles, & advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Before Stony Brook, Pikiell was an assistant at GW under Karl Hobbs from 01-05. Prior to GW, Pikiell served as an assistant at Central Connecticut State (97-01). During his tenure at CCSU, the Blue Devils notched an 81-63 record, including a 25-6 mark in 99-00 and a bid to the 00' NCAA tournament. It marked the school's 1<sup>st</sup> NCAA berth. He was part of a CCSU staff that recorded 3 straight winning seasons, including the 25-6 campaign which set a new NEC record for wins in a single season. Pikiell was a four-year letterwinner from 87-91 at UConn. UConn won its 1<sup>st</sup> Big East title & advanced to the Elite 8 & Sweet 16 during the 2 years that Pikiell captained the Huskies. Pikiell stayed on under Calhoun at UConn in 91-92 to begin his coaching career. After 1 season with the New Haven Skyhawks of the USBL (92), Pikiell spent 3 years as an assistant at Yale (92-95). He then moved on to take over as interim head coach at Wesleyan for 1 year.



Muhlenburg College

**Scott McClary** has led the Mules to a 100-82 (.549) record & 4 Centennial Conference playoff berths, & 1 Centennial Conference championship game in 6 seasons. McClary spent 7 years as an assistant coach with the Mules helping lead them to CC championships in 95 & 98. McClary came back to Muhlenburg after 6 years as head coach at Marymount University, where he compiled a 74-83 record, including winning records the last 3 seasons. In 2009, he was named CAC coach of the year after leading the Saints to 9 wins in their last 13 games & a run to the CAC championship game. Prior to Marymount, McClary was the top asst at Coastal Carolina University. McClary also spent 3 seasons at Bishop O'Connell HS. Under Morgan Wooten, he spent the 98-99 season on DeMatha's bench, McClary helped coach a team that was ranked No. 1 in the nation & featured future NBA players Keith Bogans and Joe Forte.



Shepherd University

**Justin Namolik** led the Rams to a 4th consecutive season with a .500 win % or better for the 1<sup>st</sup> time since 90-94. The 13-14 team went 20-10 & finished 3rd in conference. He was an asst coach with the Rams from 06-08. Prior to Shepherd, Namolik was the top assistant coach at St. Vincent College for 3 seasons, where he helped lead the Bearcats to a 68-24 record and 2 "Sweet 16" appearances in the NAIA DII National Tournament. Namolik played at Columbia University. He is the all-time leader in games started in Columbia history & is currently ranked 20th on the all-time scoring list with 1,040 career points. A WV native, Namolik was 1st Team All-State for Wheeling Park High School & helped lead the team to a 24-2 record, a #1 ranking in state, & the 95' AAA West Virginia State Championship.



Mt. St. Mary's University

**Will Holland** - Will Holland enters his 1<sup>st</sup> season on the Mount staff after spending 3 seasons with St. Francis (PA). In 14-15, Holland helped lead the SFU guards to the 3<sup>rd</sup> best 3-pt% in the NEC. The Flash won 10 of 13 games in which it hit at least 8 3-pointers. On the other end of the floor, the Red Flash finished 51st of more than 340 Div. 1 teams and third in the NEC with its 3-pt defense, holding opponents to just 31.6% from beyond the arc. In 13-14, Holland coached point guard Malik Harmon to NEC Rookie of the Year honors. Holland played professionally in Portugal, Mexico, and even with the Washington Generals. Holland played at The Mount & was a team captain his Jr & Sr seasons, a 2-time participant in the NEC championships & conference semifinals, & led the NEC in 3-pt% (51%) in 09-10.
